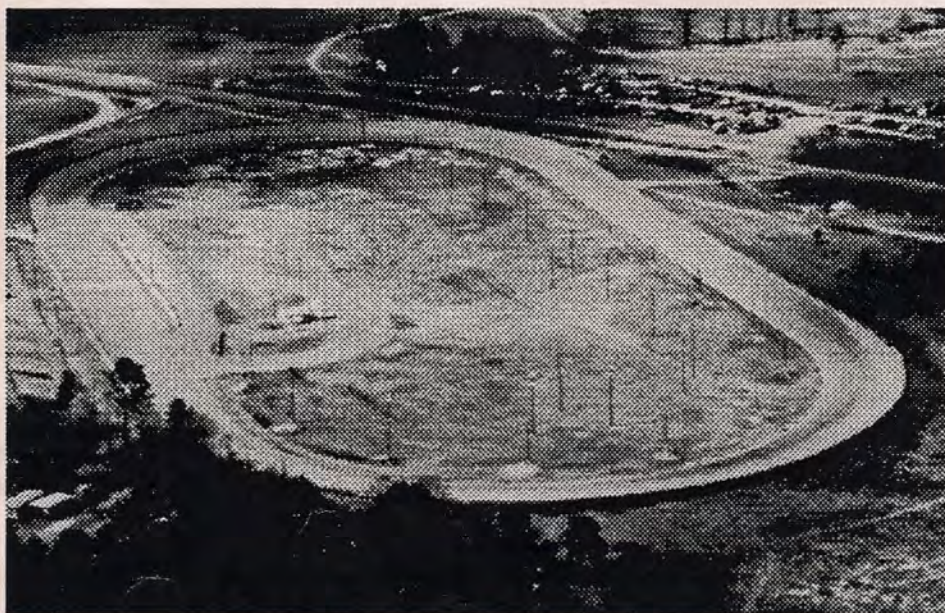

## The Perfect Oval, Not!

Have you ever wondered why your favorite car seems to handle better at one end of the track than the other? It's a half mile oval right, not!

Montgomery Motor Speedway is actually one of the longest half mile tracks around. The outside on the track measures 3000 ft. and the inside measures 2700 ft. with the favored groove measuring about 2850 ft. The track is 60 ft. wide all the way around but at times it gets awful narrow during the race when a driver is looking for a place to go during an altercation.

Turns 1 and 2 are just a little longer than turns 3 and 4 making the car handle a bit different. The distance in turns 1 and 2 is 700 ft. and turns 3 and 4 measures only 650 ft. 50 ft. doesn't sound like much, but going into a turn at 100 m.p.h. really makes a difference

in the way a car handles. The turns are banked between 12 to 15 degrees making the crew chiefs job even harder to hit that perfect setup.

If it seems to you that the cars go faster down the front stretch than the back, it's very possible, since the front stretch is 100 foot longer. The front measures 700 ft. to the backs 600 ft., with each being banked about 3 to 5 degrees.

Our track was last resurfaced in 1991 and over this past winter the cracks were sealed to help preserve its condition. Although the surface is not as good as it once was, racers still consider it as one of the best short tracks in the southeast. Could this be why a certain 'new racing series' is excited about the possibility of racing at Montgomery Motor Speedway?

# Birthday Wish Come True

Oh what a birthday present! When Prattville's Donald "Ray Ray" Wright noticed that Montgomery Motor Speedway season opening "Coca-Cola Classic" was going to be held on his 16th birthday, he knew then what he wanted for his birthday! You would have thought he had already blown the candles out on his birthday cake, cause his wish came true.

Saturday, March 16th, Ray Ray dominated the 10-car field to win his first ever Cadet Division feature race event. Starting on the outside pole position he quickly took his 1977 Monte Carlo to the front. He was challenged in the 10-lap event but he never relinquished the lead.

Wright raced in the Cadet Division in the 95 season, but his best finish was a third. In the nine race events he participated in, his goal was to win. However, the learning experience from those nine races no doubt paid off.

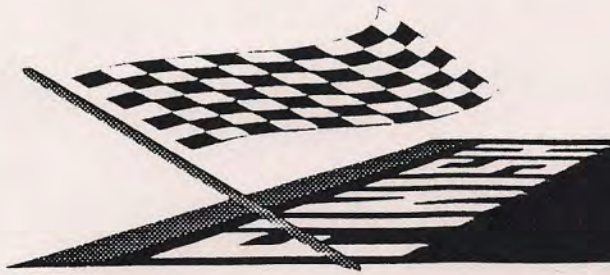
